**FROM THE GENERAL MANAGER'S DESK****November, 2010**

Triple digits have disappeared. We are finally beginning to enjoy more comfortable weather, with the ability to go outside, take walks, while participating in other outdoor activities without jeopardizing one's health. Many of our snowbirds are in the process of returning as can be seen by the number of residents using the facilities, coming into the office and observing the number of lights on at night in the windows of the various buildings. Activities will ramp-up within the next few months so please refer to the flyers around the Community and postings in the newsletter and on the website.

There have been some changes in both the Maintenance and Accounting Departments over the course of the summer and all is running smoothly as we brace for the pressures that rise when all of our residents are back in town. The staff communicates through the use of *paggers* on two channels. One of our repeaters, serving channel 2 ended its useful life and had to be replaced and several of our lounge chairs at the various pools (particularly 1 and 3) began to show wear and tear by material fraying. We have chosen a replacement material that coordinates with the current fabric and the chairs requiring upgrade have been repaired. We purchased the materials in bulk (saves a great deal of cost) so that as the fabric on additional chairs succumb to use they can be recovered at less cost.

The work in Garage 21 is continuing and while I do not have a completion date, it should not be too long from now. During the renovation and repairs we have allocated several parking areas for Regime I residents only. As you leave the community, just prior to exiting the gate, there are two parking areas, one a recessed parking lot, the other comprised 14 parking spots to your right as you exit, all of which have been marked by signs as handicapped parking for 21 residents only. The recessed parking lot next to building 27 is now reserved for use by RCI employees and vehicles only, and is gated. This may create a degree of parking pressure for the next few months, until the garage 21 project is completed. Please respect the signs and do not park in these above ground areas.

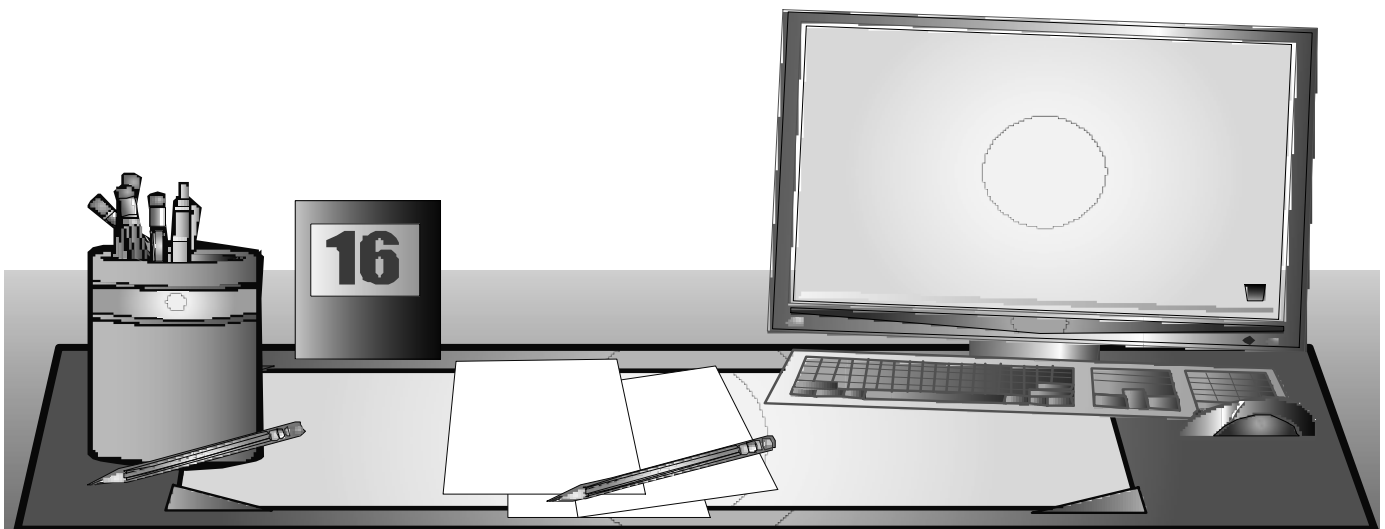
You will notice an additional canopy adjacent to the gatehouse to cover the cart parking area, and one that has been added to the area in front of the maintenance department. Re-construction of the fountain area between buildings 25 and 28 is almost completed (accomplished by our own staff), and the City, as has been mentioned in a previous article has been completed. Turning into our Community from Camelback Road no longer appears to represent a hazard.

You will notice many new faces in the community, since there has been a lot of movement and turnover in the past several months. It would be helpful to the Community Service staff if you would carry with you, your identification pass, or guest pass, at all times, particularly when you intend to use any of the amenities. At some point in the near future, (possibly when our winter residents return to their other homes), it will be necessary to close the upper deck at pool 1. This will be necessitated by the fact that after Regime I completes the garage repairs, it will have to begin work on the upper deck to secure the garage from further intrusion of water. We have an alternative to the upper deck that will become effective in about April or May of 2011.

Finally, there are residents who apparently do not believe in adhering to our 15 MPH speed limit signs.. As a result we are going to place yellow flashing warning (hazard) lights as you enter the area of the first tee and as you travel around the curve behind building 29. These lights will only operate after dark, until about 1:00AM, and will not interfere with any resident's Unit. They can only be seen as you approach them. This will provide an additional layer of safety for our residents. South West Gas had determined that its underground gas piping has reached its useful life and within the next several months they will be replacing same with new pipes. I don't know when they intend to start or how long it will take to complete the project, however we will have to endure this construction. This too, may, although it is uncertain at this time, impact our above-ground parking availability.

The Staff and I welcome you back to the Shadows, and we look forward to a pleasant, active and safe winter.

November 5 ***Precious*** running time 109 minutes **R** ***Starring: Gabourey Sidibe & Lenny Kravitz.*** *Monster's Ball* producer Lee Daniels follows up his 2005 directorial debut, *Shadowboxer*, with this adaptation of author Sapphire's best-selling novel about an overweight, illiterate African-American teen from Harlem who discovers an alternate path in life after she begins attending a new school. Clareece "Precious" Jones is only a teenager, yet she's about to give birth to her second child. Unable to read or write, Clareece shows little prospect for the future until discovering that she has been accepted into an alternative school. There, with a little help from a sympathetic teacher (Paula Patton) and a kindly nurse (Lenny Kravitz), the young girl receives something that most teens never get -- a chance to start over. Mo'nique co-stars in an inspirational drama featuring the debut performance of screen newcomer Gabourey "Gabbie" Sidibe.

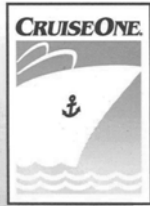

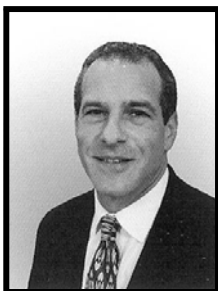

#### **RULES FOR OWNERS & RESIDENTS**

There are other Rules and Regulations of Both RCI and Regimes I thru VII that can be found in the Rules & Regulations of Scottsdale Shadows – these represent MOVE-IN/MOVE-OUT Fees and Rules

#### **SPEED AROUND PROPERTY 15 MPH/NO CUTTING THROUGH GARAGES**

- **IMPOUND FEE** (6 x monthly maintenance) NOT A PREPAYMENT OF MAINTENANCE FEES. It remains with the Regime, and is returned or credited in accordance with the Rules and Regulations, when you sell your Unit.
- **POOL KEY** Obtain from owner (also opens all of the fence gates)
- **MAILBOX KEY** obtain previous owner or have the lock changed and pay for a new one by contacting the Post Office.
- **PAYMENT BOOKS** for Monthly Maintenance Fee, obtain from owner or Administration Office
- **LATE FEES** for maintenance payments apply after the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month
- **ID BADGE** for each resident family member at the Registration & Records Office.
- **BAR CODE** for your car at the Registration & Records Office. (Registration, Insurance Info and copy of License required). [\$7.00 per bar code, after receiving 1<sup>st</sup> Code].
- **EMERGENCY INFORMATION SHEET** Fill out and deliver to the Registration & Records Office.
- **PHONE DIRECTORY** obtain from Registration & Records Department
- **SPARE SET OF KEYS** We recommend you maintain a set at the Guard Shack.
- **MOVE-IN/MOVE-OUT DEPOSIT** \$200.00 **REFUNDABLE** (pays for any damage). To be deducted from the deposit-any deficiency to be paid by Owner.
- **ADDITIONAL FEES-** See reverse side of this form
