September 4 ***State of Play*** running time 128 minutes **PG-13** *Starring:* **Russell Crowe, & Ben Affleck.** A suspicious circumstances that set a rising congressman and a dogged reporter on a dangerous collision course. U.S. congressman Stephen Collins is handsome, unflappable, and ascending the ladder of power with unprecedented speed. He's the future of his political party, and as the chairman of a committee assigned to oversee defense spending, he's got all the right connections. As the presidential race draws near, Washington insiders begin to speculate that Collins will earn his party's nomination for the country's top job. Collins was once a close friend to Cal McAffrey, now a top reporter in the nation's capitol. Assigned the task of investigating Collins by his ruthless editor, McAffrey recruits fellow reporter Della in order to track down the truth and identify the killer. But McAffrey has just walked into a cover-up of unprecedented proportions, and in a game where billions of dollars are at stake, life, love, and integrity are luxuries that simply cannot be afforded.

September 11 ***Local Color*** running time 107 minutes **R** *Starring:* **Armin Mueller-Stahl, Trevor Morgan, & Ray Liotta** John is a shy, introverted teenager from Port Chester, NY, who is fascinated with art and would like to become a painter someday -- an ambition that does not please his father, who would prefer his son spend his time playing ball and chasing girls. John is a great admirer of Nicholi Seroff, a little-known but well-respected Russian impressionist, and to his surprise he discovers that the great Seroff is living in New York these days. John pays him a visit hoping for some tutoring from the master, only to be told by Seroff that he's no longer interested in painting before slamming the door in John's face. But John is persistent, and after bribing his would-be mentor with some Russian vodka, Seroff grudgingly allows the young student to tag along with him as he heads to Pennsylvania for the summer, where he can pass along some of what he knows in exchange for John handling the household chores. Despite his dad's objections, John eagerly takes the offer.....

September 18 ***Sunshine Cleaning*** running time 91 minutes **R** *Starring:* **Amy Adams, & Emily Blunt.** A thirty-something single mother whose boundless potential was squandered through a series of failed relationships and a misguided effort to help her younger sister succeed in life finds the fruits of her labors finally coming together in director Christine Jeff's dark family comedy. Back in high school, the future looked pretty bright for Rose Lorkowski, not only was she the cheerleading captain, but she was also dating the star quarterback. Flash forward a little over a decade, and Rose is working overtime in hopes of getting her son into a better school. Her sister, Norah is still living at home with their father, Joe, a failed salesman whose penchant for jumping into get-rich-quick schemes has left the family without a financial net to fall back on. 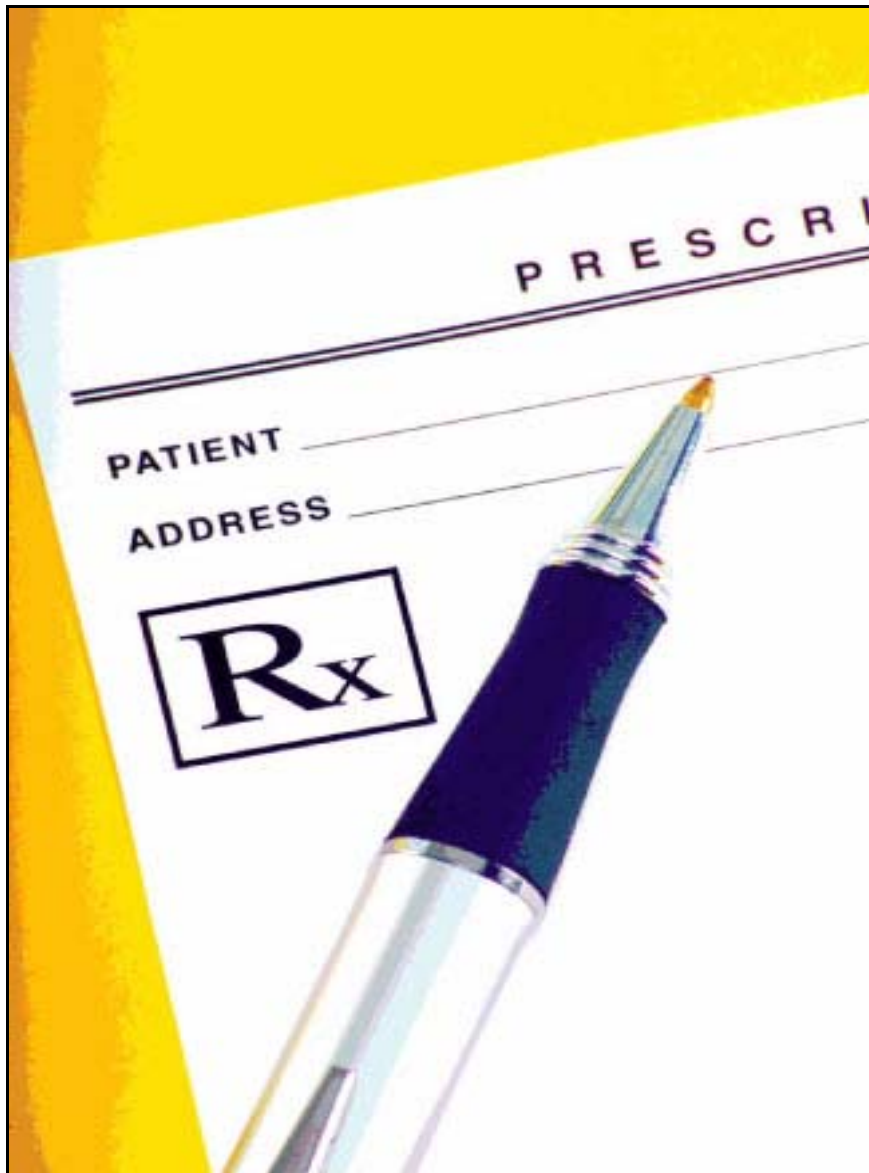
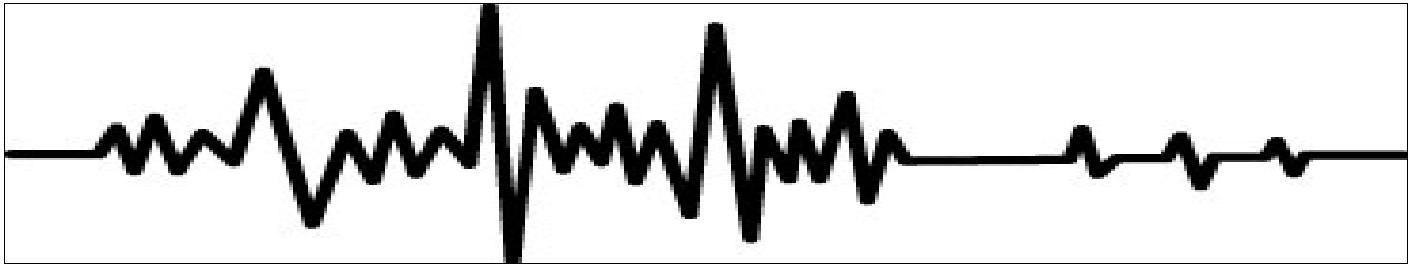

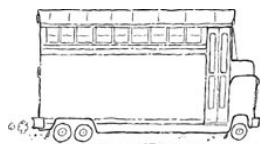
